1. If corrective strategies are unsuccessful, the clinical site has the right to terminate a student's affiliation.
2. The CI (and CCCE) has access to the program faculty's library.
3. The CI is considered in a pool of candidates for the New England Physical Therapist Assistant Consortium annual CI recognition award.
4. The CI (and CCCE) may ask academic faculty for free in-services on clinical educational issues.
5. The CI (and CCCE) may participate in the program's professional courses.
