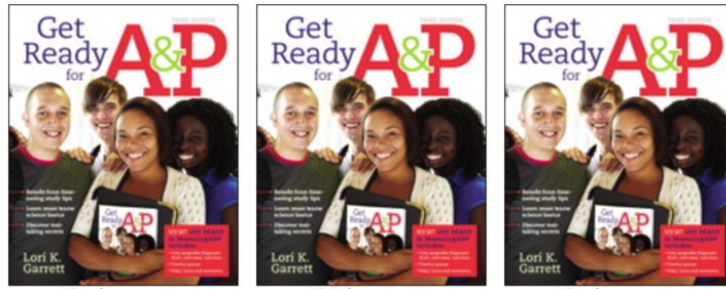


INCOMING NURSING STUDENTS

Prepare for Bio 261 in Advance



You are registered for Human Anatomy and Physiology (Bio 261) during your first fall semester. To ensure that you are prepared for the Anatomy & Physiology I course you must complete the "Get Ready for A&P" preparatory workbook this summer (we recommend completing the workbook in August so the material is fresh when classes begin):

Students should choose the third option (Premium Website with Pearson eText-Instant Access--for Get Ready for A&P, 3rd Edition). This does not expire.

- The cost is \$39.99
- Go to your Home Page and take the Diagnostic Test. You can then work through the Chapters by taking the Pre-Tests completing the activities, and taking the Post-Tests in the 6 chapters (Study Skills, Basic Math Review, Terminology, Body Basics, Chemistry & Cell Biology).
- Finally, students should take the Cumulative Test and have that final score emailed to Lorelei.locke@maine.edu. You should also have a copy emailed to yourself and print a copy for your records.
- This final test is taken only once. For students to be prepared and succeed in their fall semester course of Anatomy & Physiology (BIO261), it is expected that students receive an 80% or higher on this Cumulative Test.
